<p>Level 3 In most writing</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I write mainly in simple and compound sentences <i>e.g. The cat ran away because it was frightened.</i> With help, I can vary my sentences starts I use simple connectives like: and, but, so, because, then, when Sometimes I use different tenses <i>e.g. Yesterday it rained but today it is sunny.</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I use capital letters, full stops, question marks, exclamation marks to show the start and end of sentences I use some speech punctuation Sometimes I use commas in my sentences for lists I sometime use commas in drop-in or subordinate clauses (<i>but I don't always get it right!</i>) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I organise my ideas and try to link them together I try to write clear openings and closings I put most of my ideas into a sensible order 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I use paragraphs/ sections to group my ideas My sentences link together, for example, by using pronouns (he, she, it) My writing has some simple links between paragraphs / sections <i>e.g. I can use words or phrases to start my paragraphs – 'At the same time', 'However', 'Afterwards'</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can include suitable ideas and content I can add more detail and make my writing more descriptive <i>e.g. Adverbial phrases: She skipped along the beach happily</i> <i>e.g. Instead of using the word dog, I can give it a more interesting noun like Boxer or Spaniel</i> I try to take on a viewpoint and write my opinions or I give my characters' opinions 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can write a range of texts that have a purpose for the reader I try to use the main features of different types of text I can use some features of style to interest the reader <i>e.g. I can add humour or ask questions to the reader</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I choose words to suit the purpose of my writing I don't repeat words but use interesting synonyms <i>e.g. laugh, giggle, snigger</i> I try to choose some words to have a particular effect on the reader 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can spell many common words correctly I can spell longer common words. This includes some compound words 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> My handwriting can be read by other people I always form my letters correctly I sometimes use joined writing.
