Extra teacher in Maths setting for Y5 and 6	£42,327	Continued activity	Daily Maths teaching within setting groups with targeted teaching (30 pupils)
Nurture Group Teacher and TAs	£46,145	Termly reviewed activity	Children are part of the nurture unit for a whole morning every day to assist in their learning and emotional well-being development. (4 pupils)
Precision Teaching	£2,916	Termly reviewed activity	Children do short 5 minute activities daily to target an area of development with a TA in either Literacy or Maths (11 pupils)
Fine and Gross Multi-skills	£2,622	Termly reviewed activity	Daily 20 minute sessions involving OT recommended programs (14 pupils)
Phonics	£27,357	Termly reviewed activity	14 groups setting across the school for 20 minutes phonic sessions every day. (14 pupils)
Numicon	£3,745	Termly reviewed activity	Children work with a TA to focus on number skills, number bonds and understanding of basic mathematical language, using Numicon as a visual aid to do so. (10 pupils)
Play Therapist	£8550	On-going reviews	Trained play therapist works on a weekly basis dealing with SEMH aspects (1 pupil)
Speech and Language Therapist for Intervention Groups	£2,247	Termly reviewed activity	Children work with a TA 1:1 or in very small groups to work on specific speech and language outcomes given by a therapist from the Berkshire Healthcare team. (12 pupils)

Attention Group	£1,123	Termly reviewed activity	Children work in recommended strategies from Educations Psychologist to develop children's attention skills and memory processing (6 pupils)
Dyslexia Group	£4,495	Continued activity	Children, who have completed a screening process and been assessed as a high probability for dyslexia, work with a TA using 2 computer programs to assist them with their reading and spelling progression. (12 pupils)
Social Skills	£1,123	Termly reviewed activity	A trained Emotional Literacy Support Assistant works on recommended social and communication areas for development (6 pupils)
Educational Psychologist Group	£749	Short-term activity	Children work on solution focused projects on a 1:1 basis with the school's Education Psychologist (2 pupils)
