Include plenty of images and some explanations about the questions above. Use your ICT skills to safely download images. Build on your knowledge from Task 1 to help you complete Task 2.


(Please do not worry if you do not have Word or PowerPoint, please feel free to use any computer program that you can access.)

**This task is to help you enhance your presentation skills.**




Step 3, begin editing the page, start with the title.





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
Step 4, you can insert a 'new slide' and choose a layout from the options. This can be found at the top left-hand corner.





## EMBRACE OUR DIFFERENCES

This is an example of how your slide may look.



A picture has been added now. Drag the corners one at a time to reduce or enlarge the size of the image.

Next, click on the diversity side and begin to type up your research about diversity. Do the same for all the pages that you will have created. This is an example of how it might look.

Discover and explore your program, don't be afraid to try new things. Enjoy your task and as always send in your work to your teacher and show us how proud you are of your work.

## Extension Task.



Once you have completed creating and editing your presentation, remember to save your work. Practice reading the pages out loud to yourself.
