

Spelling rule	The sounds /n/ spelt 'kn' and less often 'gn' at the beginning of words	The sounds /r/ spelt 'wr' at the beginning of words	The sound /s/ spelt 'c' before e, i and y	The sound /j/ spelt with '-dge' and '-ge' at the end of words	The sound /j/ often spelt with g before e, i and y.
