How will you ensure it is strong enough? (In your homework book)	Create a detailed fact file about one of the 4 ancient dynasties (Egypt, Indus Valley, Sumer or Shang). Remember to include a title, facts and diagrams or pictures.
English	Spellings (COMPULSORY) Reading 5 times a week (COMPULSORY)	Write a list of at least ten adjectives to describe an Egyptian artefact. (In your homework book.)	Write a poem about Egypt/Egyptians (In your homework book.)	Create an advert about Egypt to persuade others to visit on holiday. (In your homework book)	Carry out a changing state investigation. If you are using hot water, an adult must be present. You could melt ice, or observe what happens when you run a shower. Record however you choose
Maths	Time table practice (TT Rockstars, My Maths or write out tables. (In your homework book.)	Measure the height of people in your home. Use < and > symbols when recording their heights. (In your homework book.)	Draw around five different sized leaves that you can find and then calculate the area of them. (Ask your teacher for squared paper.)	How many different ways can you make the number 777? (Ask your teacher for squared paper.)	Find out about five Volcanoes in the world and record the height of each and present in a mathematical way e.g. bar graph. (Ask your teacher for squared paper.)
Science	Draw and label a diagram of the three states (Solid, Liquid and Gas) (In your homework book.)	Create a quiz for the class to complete on solids, liquids and gases. (In your homework book.)	List as many everyday processes that involve a change of state. (e.g. evaporation, melting, freezing) (In your homework book.)	Using ICT take photos of changing states that you find around about the home and your environment. Present as you choose using ICT. (Powerpoint, word document, publisher, photo slide show.)	Create and write up (in any way you want) an investigation to show a changing state. (In your homework book.)
