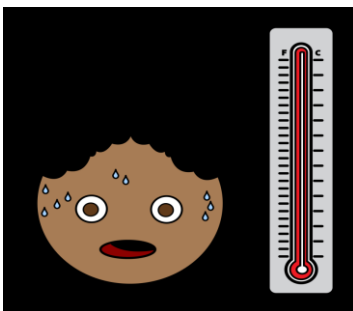


# Coronavirus Story – The Kennet Federation

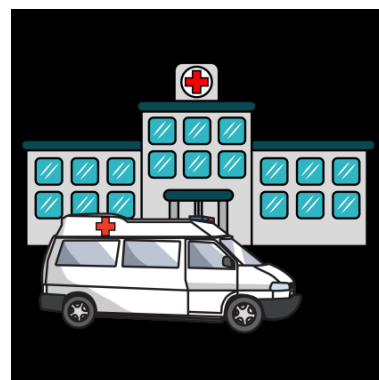
School will be different for a few weeks because most of our friends are learning at home.

Most people who have Coronavirus will stay at home and get better. Some people will have to go to hospital to get better.



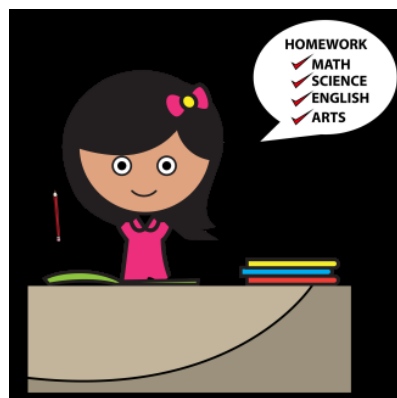
Lots of people are staying at home to stop Coronavirus from spreading.

Children will need to listen to their teachers very carefully and follow something called 'The Hygiene Protocol'. Your teachers will talk to you about this.

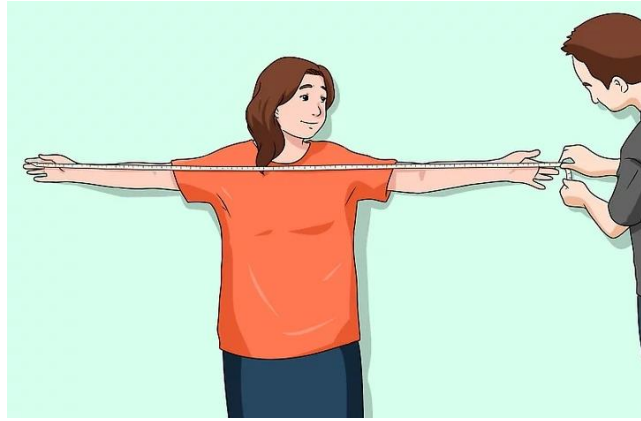


We all need to wash our hands for 20 seconds every time we go into a new area
